

## **Covid-19 data for Friday, May 29**

**There are 77 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 4,866.**

**There are 12 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 418. Currently, there are 95 people in the hospital with Covid symptoms.**

**There are 5 new deaths (1 in Beadle County and 4 in Minnehaha), so the total number of deaths now stands at 59.**

**Currently, there are 1,063 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.**

**There are 46 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 3,744.**

**There are 1,583 new negative tests reported which brings the total number of negative tests performed to 35,816.**

**In total, 12.0% of all Covid tests that have been performed since the beginning of the outbreak have been positive. 4.6% of all Covid tests in the past 24 hours have been positive.**

**The new cases reported today are located in: Beadle County (32), Brookings (1), Brown (3), Buffalo (1), Davison (1), Edmunds (1), Grant (2), Jerauld (1), Kingsbury (1), Lake (1), Lawrence (2), Meade (3), Minnehaha (12), Pennington (15) and Spink (1).**

**Currently, there are 154 positive cases associated with Demkota beef plant employees in Aberdeen. 125 of those cases are listed as recovered.**

**There are 74 positive cases at the JSI beef jerky plant in Alpena. 25 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.**

**As of today, a total of 7,340 residents and staff at SD's long term care facilities have been tested. Any results from those tests are reflected in the daily composite and county-by-county updates.**
