

Covid-19 data for Thursday, May 7

There are 126 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 2,905. (Note: a number of the new positive cases that are being reported today are a result of the mass testing event that was held for Smithfield employees earlier this week.)

There are 6 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 236.

There are 2 new deaths (both in Minnehaha County), so the total number of deaths now sits at 31.

Currently, there are 846 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.

There are 51 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 2,028.

There are 572 new negative tests reported which brings the total number of negative tests performed to 17,209.

The new cases reported today are located in: Brown County (17), Hughes (1), Lincoln (1), Minnehaha (101), Moody (4), Union (2).

There were 600+ tests run at the mass testing event in Sioux Falls yesterday. That goes with about 1,500 that were run on Monday and about 1,100 that were run on Tuesday.
