

Covid-19 data for Wednesday, June 17

There are 84 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 6,050.

There are 8 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 570. Currently, there are 91 people in the hospital with Covid symptoms.

There is 1 new death (Lincoln County resident) reported in the past 24 hours, so the total number of deaths now sits at 78.

Currently, there are 829 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.

There are 74 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 5,143.

There are 1,702 new negative tests reported which brings the total number of negative tests performed to 62,938.

In total, 8.8% of all Covid tests that have been performed since the beginning of the outbreak have been positive. 4.7% of all Covid tests in the past 24 hours have been positive.

The new cases reported today are located in: Beadle County (15), Bennett (1), Bon Homme (2), Brookings (1), Brown (2), Brule (2), Buffalo (1), Charles Mix (5), Clay (2), Codington (1), Corson (1), Hughes (2), Lake (1), Lawrence (1), Lincoln (1), Lyman (6), Minnehaha (11), Oglala Lakota (1), Pennington (22), Todd (2), Tripp (1), Walworth (1) and Yankton (2).

Currently, there are 166 positive cases associated with Demkota beef plant employees in Aberdeen. 161 of those cases are listed as recovered.

There are 120 positive cases at the JSI beef jerky plant in Alpena. 101 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.

There are 77 positive cases at the Dakota Provisions turkey plant in Huron. 48 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.

There are 853 positive cases at the Smithfield Foods plant in Sioux Falls. 849 are officially listed as recovered.

There are 35 residents and 16 staff who have tested positive at the Aventura Arrowhead long term care facility in Rapid City.

As of today, 7,630 long term care and assisted living facility residents and 9,789 staff have been tested (17,419 total). That represents 91% of all staff and residents in the state. So far, 38 residents and 32 staff at those facilities have tested positive for Covid-19 (0.40%).
