

Covid-19 data for Monday, July 20

There are 37 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 7,943.

There are 0 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 774. Currently, there are 65 people in the hospital with Covid symptoms.

There are 0 new deaths reported in the past 24 hours, so the total number of deaths now sits at 118.

Currently, there are 829 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.

There are 44 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 6,996.

There are 530 new negative tests reported which brings the total number of negative tests performed to 90,711.

In total, 8.1% of all Covid tests that have been performed since the beginning of the outbreak have been positive. 6.5% of all Covid tests in the past 24 hours have been positive.

The new cases reported today are located in: Davison County (2), Douglas (1), Hutchinson (1), Lawrence (1), Lincoln (5), Miner (1), Minnehaha (15), Oglala Lakota (2), Pennington (5), Union (3) and Yankton (1)

14 congregate living facility providers with 38 locations have scheduled mass testing events. These mass testing events will cover 909 staff and 642 residents. To date, 212 staff (0 positive cases) and 171 residents (4 positive cases) have been tested. This represents just over 1.0% positive tests.
