

Covid-19 data for Thursday, July 9

There are 94 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 7,336.

There are 9 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 718. Currently, there are 61 people in the hospital with Covid symptoms.

There are 3 new deaths reported in the past 24 hours (1 in Pennington, 1 in Todd and 1 in Yankton), so the total number of deaths now sits at 101.

Currently, there are 904 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.

There are 51 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 6,331.

There are 990 new negative tests reported which brings the total number of negative tests performed to 79,974.

In total, 8.4% of all Covid tests that have been performed since the beginning of the outbreak have been positive. 8.6% of all Covid tests in the past 24 hours have been positive.

The new cases reported today are located in: Beadle County (2), Bon Homme (1), Brown (2), Brule (3), Buffalo (5), Charles Mix (1), Clay (2), Codington (4), Davison (1), Dewey (15), Grant (1), Gregory (1), Hanson (1), Hughes (3), Lake (1), Lincoln (5), Lyman (5), McCook (1), Minnehaha (17), Oglala Lakota (5), Pennington (10), Roberts (2), Todd (1), Turner (1), Union (2), Yankton (1) and Ziebach (1)

Currently, there are 170 positive cases associated with Demkota beef plant employees in Aberdeen. 167 of those cases are listed as recovered.

There are 129 positive cases at the JSI beef jerky plant in Alpena. 122 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.

There are 104 positive cases at the Dakota Provisions turkey plant in Huron. 98 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.

There are 67 positive cases among residents and staff at the Avantara Arrowhead long term care facility in Rapid City. 54 of those cases are officially listed as recovered.
