

Covid-19 data for Monday, August 10

There are 58 new cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota reported in the past 24 hours. That brings the total number of cases to 9,663.

There are 6 new hospitalizations in the state which brings the total number of people ever hospitalized in South Dakota to 882. Currently, there are 63 people in the hospital with Covid symptoms.

There are 0 new deaths reported in the past 24 hours, so the total number of deaths stays at 146.

Currently, there are 1,146 active cases of Covid-19 in South Dakota.

There are 37 new recoveries in the past 24 hours. The total number of recoveries now sits at 8,371.

There are 1,091 new tests reported in the past 24 hours. To date, there have been 153,507 tests performed on 121,477 unique individuals.

11.7% of all Covid tests in the past 24 hours have been positive.

7.4% of all Covid tests in the past 7 days have been positive.

7.3% of all Covid tests in the past 14 days have been positive.

7.3% of all Covid tests have been positive since the start of the pandemic.

New cases were not reported by county.

At Camp Judson near Keystone, 81 individuals of the 96 confirmed cases are listed as recovered.

There is also an outbreak at McCrossan's Boys Ranch outside Sioux Falls. So far, 16 of 37 positive cases are listed as recovered.

To date, 299 residents of long-term care facilities have tested positive which has resulted in 65 deaths among long-term care facility residents. This breaks out to 20.3 positive tests/1,000 long-term care residents (5th lowest in the nation).

In addition, 243 staff have tested positive.

Dept. of Health plans to do testing of all EMS, law enforcement and fire departments starting approximately two weeks after the end of the Sturgis rally.

All public universities have Abbott ID testing machines on campus. DOH is also planning to offer sentinel testing to all K-12 school districts. If a district accepts the DOH offer, random, asymptomatic adults will be tested periodically. DOH will maintain testing supplies for this program.
